- ⇒ 1 to 2 years of experience in a related field is preferred

- ★ Knowledge of animal control principles and practices

- Patrols the county to preserve law and orders and to serve civil papers

- Performs animal control duties; issues citations for violations; removes animals from inhumane conditions; contains loose livestock; investigates dog bites and animal cruelty cases
- **⇒** Secures and maintains order in the Magistrate Courtroom
- ⇒ Performs evictions; explains legal procedures to defendants during evictions, repossessions, levies, etc.
- Organizes daily civil process papers; completes daily logs
- Answers questions and provides information to the general public
- ⇒ Assists other agencies as requested
- ⇒ Performs all other related duties as assigned
