

TROUP COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

“MEETINGS NOTICE”

(Regular meeting schedule/notice is also posted on the Troup County website – <http://troupcountyga.gov>)

- Regular meetings of the Troup County Board of Commissioners are held on the first and third Tuesday of each month in the first floor Commission Chambers of the Troup County Government Center located at 100 Ridley Avenue in LaGrange, Georgia. The meetings begin at 9:00 a.m. with a work session and, at the conclusion of the work session portion of the meeting, are adjourned until 5:00 p.m. While the work session portion of the meeting is generally informational only, if circumstances require it, votes may be taken.
- All meetings other than regular meetings (“Called” meetings) shall be announced through posting in the Troup County Government Center at 100 Ridley Avenue at least 24 hours in advance of the meeting at the place of regular meeting and written or oral notice of all such meetings shall be given at least 24 hours in advance to the county legal organ and/or a paper that has the equivalent circulation.
- Emergency meetings may be held upon the provision of reasonable notice under the circumstances, to include (1) notice to the county legal organ or its equivalent, (2) recording in the minutes the need for the emergency meeting, and (3) providing telephonic, facsimile or e-mail notification to other media outlets that have a place of business in the County that have requested such notice.
- All members of the public who wish to address a specific topic not on the board agenda must submit their name and topic to the Commissioners’ Office (County Manager) at least three business days before the board meeting.
- By concurrence of a majority of the members present, the Board may allow public comment on items, which are on the agenda.
- Pursuant to O.C.G.A. §50-14-1 (g)(2), under circumstances necessitated by emergency conditions involving public safety or the preservation of property or public services, the Board of Commissioners may conduct meetings by teleconference so long as the notice required by Georgia Open Meetings Law is provided and means are afforded for the public to have simultaneous access to the teleconference meeting.
- As set forth and provided by the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1992, Troup County Government does not discriminate on the basis of disability and will assist citizens with special needs given reasonable prior notice.
