Fourth of July Fireworks Show Event Postponed

Troup County, Ga. June 11, 2020 – Troup County’s Annual Fourth of July Fireworks Show event, presented by Troup County Parks and Recreation, has been postponed to Saturday, August 8, 2020 due to continuing Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) precautions and restrictions put in place by Georgia Governor Brian Kemp.

While county officials understand that this delay may come as a disappointment to many of those within our community, the decision was made in order to prioritize the safety and well-being of our public. Nonetheless, the County is excited to host the rescheduled event, which will serve as a back-to-school kick-off as a way to wish all students, teachers, and families well during the upcoming school year.

Despite the change in date, the county hopes to offer traditional activities during the Pyne Road Park celebration unless otherwise noted by further restrictions. Admission entry will be \$10.00 per vehicle. The event will be sponsored by Jackson Services, who has offered outstanding support in making the event successful.
