ADDENDUM #2

1. In the scope of work the project lists that there are to be 129 posts that need to be installed. Please clarify if the 129 quantity is just to show how many posts will be receiving the 5' barb arms or if there are 129 posts that need to be replaced.
The number was provided to show how many posts need arms.
2. Please advise. When installing barb-wire on the barb arm are we to only install enough barb wire the entire length of the barb arm at 12" O.C. or just enough to support the coil of barb tape that needs to be installed.
Enough to provide support for the razor wire for now and the future to include during warrant timeline.
3. Please advise. Do we need to cover additional material on this project to replace/repair any existing barb-tape that is damaged that can be replaced during the construction phase.
Please see Addendum #1, question #10.
4. Please advise. We are required to send two copies of the bid submission forms and bid bonds shown in the ITB. As well as a digital copy of the bid submissions. Please advise if there are other documents that are required for the bid submissions to be considered valid.
No, however submission of a list of project specifications, price breakdown, and your projected timeline, along with information on your prior projects, references, and company background is not required but preferred, as it is helpful in our evaluation.
5. Please advise, is there a warranty period for this project. If so, could you please provide it.
A 5-year warrant on materials and work (craftsmanship) are required.
6. Please advise, the ITB is stating that this project must be completed within 60 consecutive workdays. Does this also include the submittal and material procurement phase of the project. If so, this is not a long enough duration to complete this project.

60 days would be preferred, however, if the project runs longer due to verified material procurement delays, etc. we are flexible. We do, however, want the project complete in a reasonable amount of time.

7. Please advise, are there liquidated damages on this project.
