Transportation is for accountability court participants (you) only. You may not bring any children, family members, or friends with you. You may use the transportation for required treatment groups, individual treatment sessions, case management, court, and drug testing only.

You are allowed transportation only to/from the Troup County Government Center, Pathways (Felony Drug Court & Mental Health Court), and Counseling Services (DUI/Drug Court). You may not use the transportation service for self-help groups. You will only be allowed to be picked up at pre-approved locations such as your primary residence or place of employment. You may be required to show a photo ID; make sure you have your lab ID at all times

This is a free service, but you can lose this service and/or be sanctioned if you violate any of these rules.

Basic Rules: Be there when the driver arrives and promptly board vehicle. Be respectful. Remain seated at all times. No smoking. No cursing. No food or beverage. No stops for special requests (convenience store, etc.).

Troup Co. Accountability Court Transportation Program



If you have been approved to use the transportation program, you may schedule a ride by calling the Housing Authority transportation coordinator at **706-616-3545**.

To schedule trips for treatment sessions, court, or self-help meetings, please call and arrange your rides a **minimum** of three (3) days beforehand. Failure to do so may prevent the transportation van from being able to schedule your pick up. To schedule trips for random drug tests please call as soon as possible the days you are asked to test. The van may not be able to schedule your transportation if you call after 10am. In addition, the earlier you call the days you are schedule the quicker you will be picked up.

You are allowed to schedule **a maximum of 10 one-way trips per week** (Going to the government center and back home counts as 2 one-way trips). Remember you are sharing this van with other participants in the accountability courts, and the transportation van is only allowed a certain number of trips a week. If you use the van more than your allowed amount you are taking rides from other participants.

You are allowed transportation to the following: The Troup County Government Center, Pathways (Felony Drug Court & Mental Health Court), Counseling Services (DUI/Drug Court), and approved self-help locations.

You are only allowed to be picked up at the following pre-approved locations: Your primary residence, place of employment, approved self-help locations, Pathways, Counseling services and the Troup County Government Center.

You may be required to show a photo ID; so please make sure you have your accountability court ID on you at all times. Transportation is for accountability court participants only, therefore you may not bring any children, family members, or friends on the van with you.

This is a free service, but you could be removed from the program if you violate any of the rules listed below.

1. Be ready to board the vehicle promptly when the van arrives.
2. If you have a phone, you must be available to answer calls from the transportation coordinator on days when you have scheduled transportation.
3. Be respectful.
4. Remain seated at all times.
5. No smoking.
6. No cursing.
7. No food or beverage.
8. No stops for special requests (convenience store, etc.)
